
Grant Fuhr: The Story of a Hockey Legend




In 2014, Fuhr was inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame.

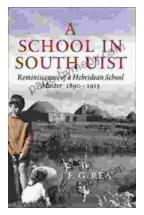
