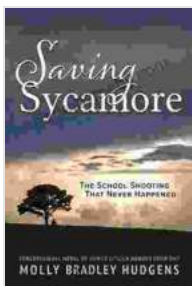


# Saving Sycamore: The School Shooting That Never Happened

The story of Sycamore is a powerful reminder that we can make a difference in the lives of our children. By working together, we can create safe and supportive schools where all students can learn and thrive.

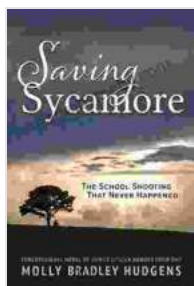

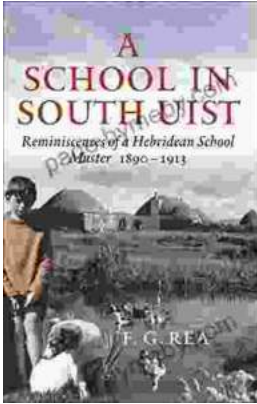
