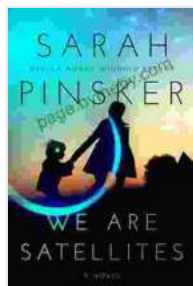


We Are Satellites: A Journey into Identity, Connection, and the Universe

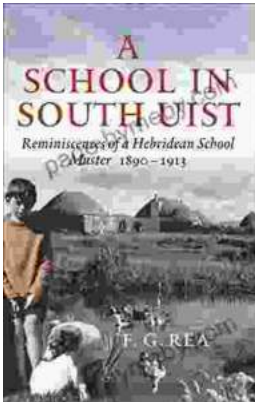
